

10 SAFETY PRINCIPLES



Lead by example and promote Safety Culture

- I respect and I reinforce safety instructions.
- I provide a secure working environment on a daily basis.

MANAGER:

- I am personally committed to the deployment of the safety policy.
- I share this commitment with all my colleagues.
- I demonstrate my commitment when making safety inspections.



Respect the zerotolerance alcohol and drug policy

- I know that driving a vehicle, using equipment or carrying out safety tasks, requires all my attention and skills.
- While at work I am not under the influence of alcohol or illicit substances.
- I agree to ask for help when needed (addiction).

MANAGER:

- I pay attention to suspicious behaviour of my colleagues.
- I organize alcohol and drug controls in compliance with the current regulations.
- I offer employees with alcohol and/or drug issues to benefit from an Employee Assistance Program.



You are responsible for your own safety and for the others

- I pay constant attention to my work environment and of my colleagues.
- I respect safety instructions related to my job and I ask my colleagues to do the same.
- I report potential safety issues to my hierarchy.

MANAGER:

- I monitor all tasks and activities of my staff and analyse the potential risks.
- I am available to discuss health & safety issues, and I implement solutions where possible in cooperation with the local Safety Committee.



Always follow procedures: Don't cut corners

- I carry out my professional tasks in the strict compliance with safety regulations.
- I do not allow myself any deviation from safety rules (traffic regulations/ laws, maintenance tasks, operations...).
- I do not hesitate to suggest improvements to my manager.

MANAGER:

- I monitor how my staff respects the safety rules in place.
- I carry out regular "safety inspections" and take note of all observations regarding safety improvements. I implement improvements where possible.



If you see something, say something

- I immediately inform my manager and/or my colleagues of any dangerous situation.
- I also report any suspicious situation or behaviour (abandoned objects, presence of unauthorized persons, suspicious behaviour...).

MANAGER:

- I put in place an alert system to take into account all security and safety warnings.
- I ensure that the means and procedures of response are in place and effective.



Respect all signals, signs and speed limits



Always wear your personal protective equipment



Ensure your workplace is tidy and all equipment well maintained



Report and investigate all the incidents in a timely manner



Share Knowledge and best practices with your colleagues

- I respect all traffic instructions in our Operations (depots, workshops, head offices...).
- I strictly respect the traffic regulations and instructions (road, stations, bus stations, car parks...).

MANAGER:

- I set up a local circulation plan which identifies all vehicle movement on the Transdev premises.
- I ensure that the plan is known and respected by all staff and any person authorized to enter Transdev premises (subcontractor, suppliers...).

- I select the appropriate protective gear before starting any work or entering a risk area.
- I make sure that the protective gear is in good condition.
- I respect the user instructions and use the protective gear correctly.

MANAGER:

- I make the appropriate protective gear for each activity available to my collaborators.
- I make sure that they know the use of each PPE and that they actually wear them at their workstations.

- I ensure that my workspace is clean and tidy, as well as circulation and storage areas.
- I sort out spare parts and dispose of any unnecessary items.
- I contribute actively to the cleaning activities in the workshop.

MANAGER:

- I support my team where possible to keep workspaces tidy and clean.
- I regularly carry out "safety inspections" to make sure that work and storage spaces are well maintained.

- I immediately report any accidents or near misses to my manager.
- I gather the information needed in order to understand the event
- I provide support to the investigation team to identify the cause (Root Cause Analysis).

MANAGER:

- I systematically analyse every safety related event including near misses.
- I involve the local safety committee and implement the recommendations.
- I inform the staff on safety related events and communicate associated corrective actions.

- I take advantage of the "toolbox discussions" (and any other opportunity) to exchange with my colleagues and my manager.
- I share my suggestions for improving safety in my daily activities (Best Practices to avoid incidents / accidents).

MANAGER:

- I organize "toolbox" meetings to raise awareness of safety issues among my colleagues.
- I listen to and take into account improvement suggestions wherever possible.
